Survey Summary

5-10-05

1. All 270 surveys from consumers, family members, providers and stakeholders ranked Mental Health Services #1 as most important.
2. All 226 consumers, providers, and stakeholders ranked Housing and Supports #2 as second most important. The 44 families ranked Housing and Supports #3 as third most important.
3. Health was ranked #3 overall with Illness Management a close #4 ranking considering all 270 surveys.
4. Dual Diagnosis and Employment Services were ranked 5th and 6th respectively followed by Consumer-run/Peer Services.

The weighted scoring is as follows:
