1. Integrated Treatment Teams - comprehensive staff training programs with financial incentives for certifications
2. Preserve & restore Pioneer & River St.
3. Move & expand Paloma
4. Add A&D beds as step down or alternative to hospital
5. Add dual dx beds with support (Stanford)
6. Consumer run transportation

1. Expand 2034 housing & employment supports
