Reasons to Become a myCAvax Provider TODAY

In anticipation of COVID-19 vaccine eligibility for everyone 6 months of age and older, public health is encouraging providers to enroll in myCAvax now. Pediatric vaccination coverage is currently low, especially for California's most vulnerable children. COVID can be serious for kids, resulting in 4 times more deaths than flu over the past two years in the U.S. Help save lives by participating in myCAvax, California's COVID-19 Vaccination Program.

Other reasons to become a myCAvax provider:

Good Incentives

- Vaccines for Children (VFC) providers will receive a **\$15,000** Calvax Grant for enrolling in myCAvax (more information to come).
- Central California Alliance for Health (CCAH) offers primary care physicans \$10,000 to enroll.
- Additional CCAH incentives: (based on Alliance members who receive their first dose between Sept. 1, 2021 and Feb. 28, 2022):
 - o For every member **aged 5 and over who receives their first dose**, the provider administering the vaccine will receive a **\$25** incentive payment.
 - o When a PCP office reaches **70% of eligible members vaccinated**, a **\$25** incentive will be paid per member who received their first vaccine dose during the measurement period.
 - o When a PCP office reaches **85% of eligible members vaccinated**, a **\$45** incentive will be paid per member who received their first vaccine dose during the measurement period.



Easier Storage and Handling

- The Pfizer vaccine now lasts at refrigerated temperatures for 10 weeks.
- You can receive **lower quantities** of the vaccine (as low as 30 doses per day) through third party redistributors.
