

COVID-19 Additional Dose Fact Sheet

Why?

COVID-19 additional doses are meant to aid those with weakened immune systems who have not responded fully to initial doses.

Who?

Individuals **ages 5** and older who completed a two-dose vaccine series AND are **moderately or severely immune compromised**.

Talk to your doctor to see if getting an additional dose is right for you.

Conditions and treatments include:

- Active cancer treatment for tumors or cancers of the blood
- Solid organ transplant and are taking medicine to suppress the immune system
- Stem cell transplant within the last 2 years or are taking medicine to suppress the immune system
- Moderate or severe primary immunodeficiency
- Advanced or untreated HIV infection
- Active treatment with drugs that suppress immune response



When?

28 days after the two-dose series of Pfizer for people ages 5-17 and either Pfizer or Moderna for people ages 18 and older.
